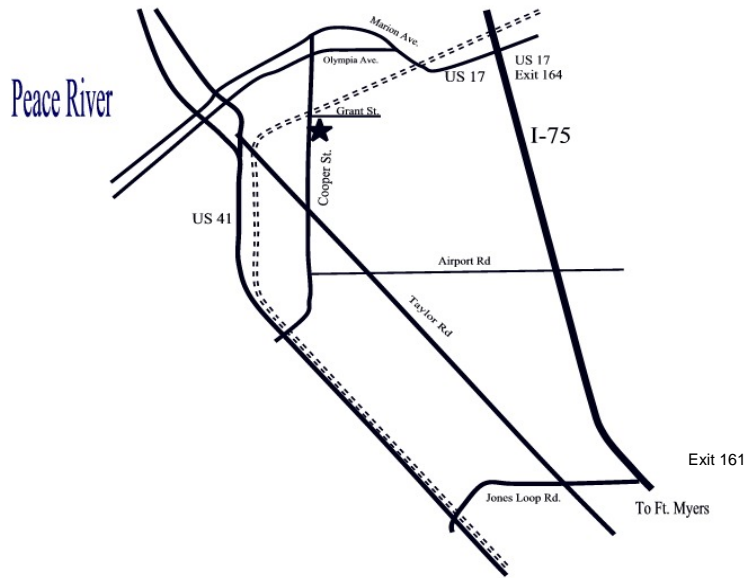

Directions to Show Site

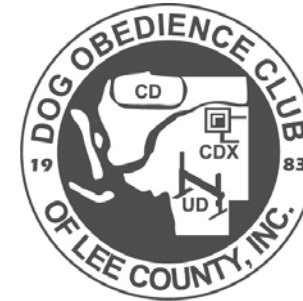

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS continued

ENTRY FEES FOR EACH TRIAL: Please be aware that Rally and Obedience are separate trials. If a dog is entered in one regular Obedience class, the fee is \$25.00. If the same dog is also entered in a regular Rally class, the additional fee is \$25.00 for a total of \$50.00. If the same dog is also entered in one additional regular Rally or Obedience class, there is an additional fee of \$13.00 for a total entry fee of \$63.00 (For example Open B, Utility B and Rally Novice) Each non-regular class is \$13.00.

RALLY AND OBEDIENCE MOVE-UPS are allowed if the owner's records indicate the dog has completed the requirements for a title after the closing date of a trial where the dog was entered. Move-ups for Saturday January 23rd trial will be accepted until Monday, January 18, 2010. The request for a move-up must be in writing and a move up form must be completed with jump heights. Please contact the trial secretary by e-mail at willowrunspringer@gmail.com or by phone 239-543-3938. Move-ups for Sunday January 24th will be accepted until the close of the trial on Saturday January 23rd, 2010.

Rally Exhibitors - New Rally Rules became effective January 1, 2008. You are responsible to understand these changes. Rally Advanced and Excellent classes will be scheduled in order of jump height. You **MUST** supply a jump height on your entry form or the entry will not be accepted by the trial secretary. The trial secretary will not contact you for this information. **Also** please be aware of the rules for entering an A or B class. The rules differ between the Rally novice class and the Advanced/Excellent classes. You are responsible for entering the correct class. Your leg will not count if you are entered in the wrong class. The trial secretary is not permitted to make changes on your entry form.

The Rally Jump heights are:
Less than 10" at withers 4" jump height
10" to 15" at withers 8" jump height
15" and under 20" 12" jump height
20" and over 16" jump height

NON-REGULAR CLASSES
WILD CARD NOVICE, WILD CARD OPEN, & WILD CARD UTILITY:

These classes are for any dog that is capable of performing the Obedience exercises and that is eligible under the Obedience Regulations to compete in AKC events. Owners may enter more than one dog in these classes, which may be handled by the owner or any other person and may be entered in other classes at this trial. The exercises (Novice, Open, & Utility) will be performed and judged according to AKC Regulations as in the regular class. These exercises will be performed in the same order as the "A" class, except that verbal praise and encouragement during the exercises will not be discouraged or penalized. However, any commands to the dog will be penalized. Upon check in at ringside, the handler will specify to the table steward the exercise the handler selects not to perform. This will be indicated on the exhibitor's score sheet, which will excuse them from the specified exercise while receiving a perfect score for that exercise. The exercises, maximum scores and order of judging in the Wild Card Classes are as described in the Obedience Regulations.

Pre-Novice exercises will be performed and judged according to AKC Regulations for these classes.

AKC titles cannot be earned in any Non-Regular class. Qualifying scores will not be required for the awarding of ribbons or prizes in these classes.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

ENTRY FEES: OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIALS: \$25.00 for the first dog in any regular class, \$13.00 for each additional entry of the same dog in the same trial. All non-regular class entries are \$13.00. **PLEASE NOTE:** Obedience and Rally are separate trials!

Included in the entry fee is a \$3.00 Event Service Fee for the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog collected by the AKC. A Recording Fee of 50¢ will also be collected for each dog entered. These fees are collected by the show giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (AKC Rule effective January 1, 2008)

Entries close at noon Wednesday Jan 6, 2010 after which time entries cannot be accepted, changed or cancelled except as allowed as a move up. Entries must be signed by owner or agent and submitted with fees. No telephone or telegraph entries can be accepted. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left without recipient signature. Entries not on official AKC forms and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the reverse side are not acceptable.

Confirmation of Entry Receipt will be e-mailed if an e-mail address is provided. If you do not provide an e-mail address, or if you do not receive confirmation of entry receipt, please call or e-mail the Trial Secretary before the closing date.

Judging schedules for ring assignments and scheduled ring times will be mailed about one week after the closing date. If an e-mail address is supplied, it will also be e-mailed. If you have not received the schedule within a reasonable time, please contact the Trial Secretary at 239-543-3938 or willowrunspringer@gmail.com.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge or veterinarian or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owners of the grounds and/or facilities, or other acts beyond the control of the club, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, NO REFUND of entry fees will be made.

Bitches that come in season after closing may have the entry fee refunded less \$5.00 upon written request from the owner or handler on or before date of trial.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.

Catalogs may be reserved by paying \$3.00 with your entry fee. There will be a limited number of catalogs available for purchase on the day of the shows. The catalog includes the entries for both Saturday and Sunday.

No dogs may be left in the building overnight. **No Exercise pens** are allowed inside the building. There is enough crating space, but please don't take more space than you need.

The exercise area is clearly marked. PLEASE clean up after your dog so we can continue to use these facilities for our trials. Our club also insists that you also clean up after your dog at the hotel or campground you are staying at so they continue to allow dogs to stay as their guests.

Misconduct at hotels may result in an Event Committee hearing.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dog is free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have all appropriate vaccinations
